Dates: Tues Aug 15 at 4.30 pm; Wed Aug 16 at 4.30 pm & 8 pm; Fri Aug 18 at 7 pm
(You may bowl multiple entries).

Check-In: Check-in time is 45-60 minutes prior to your chosen squad(s).

Divisions: Adult - open to all male and female bowlers

Senior - open to all male and female bowlers 50 years of age/older at 7/31/17

Youth - open to all boys and girls 20 years of age/younger at 7/31/17

Entry Fees: Adult \$49; Senior \$34; Youth \$29

Format: This is a singles tournament in which league bowlers are paired with three different high average bowlers from the New Mexico Open roster or local professional bowlers. Everyone bowls three games of 9-Pin No-Tap scoring.

Your professional bowlers are credited with a minimum score of 225 per game.

Handicap: Handicap is for league bowlers only and will be based on 90% of the difference between entering average and 225.

Average: Average used will be the highest current average over 21 games or more in league play as at 7/31/17. If prior season winter average or book average is higher, use that higher average.

Standings: Standings will be determined by the two-three game sets bowled by the league bowler and their professionals plus the league bowler's handicap.

Prizes: Prizes will include trophies for first place in each division.

Prize-money or scholarship money (youth) will be paid one in seven entries in all divisions. Adult winner is guaranteed \$500; senior winner is guaranteed \$250.

Note: Field size is restricted based on number of available lanes at each squad time;
Suggest EARLY ENTRY to avoid disappointment.
