### **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: DECEMBER 20, 2017**

**THIS TOURNAMENT IS A JUNIOR GOLD EVENT. There is no additional fee charged to bowl this event, but you must be a USBC Junior Gold Program Member if you qualify. The highest six game total bowled in the U12, U15 and U20 boy and girl division will be seeded to the Junior Gold Championship. YOU MUST BE ELIGIBLE FOR A JUNIOR GOLD MEMBERSHIP CARD AT TIME OF CHECK IN.**

#### **NEW MEXICO PEPSI USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES AT STATE LEVEL**

1. ELIGIBILITY: Tournament is open to all USBC certified youth members of bowling associations within the jurisdictional area of the New Mexico USBC Association.

Current membership card must be presented at check-in.

2. ENTERING AVERAGES: This is a scratch tournament

3. PRIZES AND AWARDS: Award-Prize Fund fees will be returned 100% to the bowlers in the form of Scholarships and awards, and monies will be deposited in the bowlers name with the SMART Program within 30 days from the end of the tournament. Symbolic awards will be given to at least the top three finishers in each division. Scholarships will be given in at least 1:10 ratio of participation in each Division. First place winners in the U12, U15 and U20 divisions will receive an automatic entry in the Junior Gold Championships, to be held on July 14-21, 20187 Dallas, Texas and they will receive partial travel reimbursement from NMUSBC. The advancers must be Junior Gold Program members, or be eligible and purchase a membership at the championships. If the winner is not eligible for the championships, he/she will still retain all awards from the state level, but the next eligible bowler will receive the berth to the USBC Junior Gold Championships. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the National Finals or failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. The decision to go or not must be made within 30 days after the State Pepsi Finals and the Tournament Director needs to be informed with the decision.

4. The NMUSBC Tournament Committee shall determine all matters not covered by these rules. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championship Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

5. CLASSIFIED DIVISIONS: Competition will be conducted in the following Ten (10) Divisions: U8 Boys' Scratch; U8 Girls' Scratch; U10 Boys' Scratch; U10 Girls' Scratch; U12 Boys' Scratch; U12 Girls' Scratch; U15 Boys' Scratch; U15 Girls' Scratch; U20 Boys' Scratch; U20 Girls' Scratch. Three games will be bowled in the U8 & U10 Division. Six games will be bowled in the U12, U15 & U20 Division, six games will be bowled on one pair of lanes. There is no qualifying in your local

leagues and all certified bowlers in New Mexico may participate. Any participant wanting to bowl in a category above their age must have a guardian fill out the permission form before bowling

6. ENTRY CLOSING DATE: Entries close Midnight DECEMBER 20, 2017 (Name, Address, and telephone numbers of participants, and entry fee must accompany the entry. ENTRIES WILL BE PROCESSED ON A FIRST COME BASIS, SO GET THEM IN EARLY TO GET THE SQUAD TIME YOU WANT.

7. DRESS CODE: USBC Rule 301b will apply. Members of the Board of Directors of NMUSBC, as sponsors of this Championship Tournament, request that all bowlers wear suitable attire when participating in the tournament; Slacks, Skirts or walking shorts to the knee and official USBC jerseys are preferred, bowling shirts or blouses will be allowed. NO HATS\CAPS. UNSUITABLE ATTIRE; Tank tops, workout attire (i.e. Spandex, sweatpants), Short Shorts (if a bowlers fingers are below the hemline, the Shorts are considered too short and not suitable.), Bib overalls, torn or unclean jeans, shirts or t-shirts with offensive language/graphics. Bowlers shall wear authorized bowling shoes. VIOLATIONS: Entrants will be required to change into suitable attire. Entrants who refuse to wear suitable attire will not be allowed to bowl. Tournament management reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed to be inappropriately attired without recourse. Attire needed for medical reasons must be discussed with tournament management prior to the tournament.

8. Tournament management has the discretion to disqualify any participant for unsportsmanlike conduct or unruly behavior (physical or verbal abuse of equipment or other participants). This is a non-smoking event. No tobacco or alcohol products will be allowed by participants or spectators during the tournament. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be allowed in the settee area. There will be NO use of electronic devices (video games, radios, cell phone, CD Players, etc.) on the approaches during bowling competition. If an electronic device is causing a delay of the game, the device will be confiscated and can be retrieved at the end of the event. Coaching will be allowed; but if it causes a delay in the game the offending player will be given a zero for each frame they are not ready to bowl

9. PROTEST: In case of protest involving eligibility or playing rules, the protest must be filed in writing to tournament management no later than seventy two (72) hours after completion of event USBC Rule 329. In case of scoring errors they should be reported immediately upon request.

10. A bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Frames missed will be credited with a zero. A bowler not present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn will get a zero for that frame.

11. If a tie still exists, it will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll off.
